## How to Play

### Game One:

Players choose a number and write their name in the square of their choice. Feel free to price each square at a level that suits your team. The number chosen corresponds to one of the participating teams:

Alternatively, you can write out the above teams with their corresponding numbers on individual pieces of paper and players can pick a team out of a hat. Players names are then written in their square.

At the end of the tournament the person who picked the winning team receives a proportion of the pool and the rest is donated to CLDF. It would be appreciated if the charity could receive a minimum of 25% of the pool.

### Game Two:

These squares are each based on a possible, but unusual, event that could happen throughout the tournament. To play each person chooses a number and then pays your chosen amount to play. The number chosen corresponds to one of the following events:

1. A goal is scored by any team within 30 seconds of the starting whistle of the match
2. The referee is pushed over on the pitch during a match by a player from any playing team
3. 3 red cards are issued to one team during one match
4. England win a penalty shootout at any point during the tournament
5. Saudi Arabia reach the knockout stages
6. Panama reach the knockout stages
7. A goalkeeper from any team scores a goal during a match (not including an own goal!)
8. A manager from any team is sacked during the tournament
9. 7 or more goals are scored by one team during a single match
10. 2 penalties are missed by one team during a single match (not including during a penalty shootout)

If any of these events occur the player goes into the winner's pool. At the end of the tournament the funds get divided between any players in the winning pool and CLDF. If none of the events occur, you can either return each player's stake or donate the winning pool all to CLDF!
