## QUIZ GUIDE!

Here's your Big Yellow Quiz checklist to get you started.

Have you:

- Chosen a date, time and venue for your quiz and decided on an entrance fee (will this be per person or per team?)
- Checked the venue has all the equipment you'll need (PA system, microphone, tables for the quizmaster and teams, etc.)?
- Chosen your quizmaster? If you are doing this yourself, make sure you have a practice run of asking all the questions beforehand!
- Prepared all your hand-outs? Make sure you have plenty of copies of the blank answer-sheets, picture rounds, pens etc.
- Decided how you are going to mark the quizzes (e.g. teams swapping sheets, all marked by the quiz master, etc.)?
- Finalised the quiz format (timing of breaks, how long you will allow per round, what happens if there's a tie, etc.)?
- Sorted a prize for the winning team? Ask around friends and family, local shops and restaurants to see if they are able to donate a suitable prize or voucher

### Spread the Word

- Download your Big Yellow Friday event posters from <https://childliverdisease.org/fundraising-materials/> to put up around your school, place of work or in the local community
- Advertise your event in newsletters, websites and social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.) **#BigYellowFriday**
- Send an email or text to all of your friends to make sure they get the date in their diary
- Set up a Facebook event and invite all your friends and family, so that you can keep them up to date with progress for the event and how they're helping to make a difference
- Add your event to our Big Yellow Friday map on our website

## It'll be alright on the night!

Once all your preparation is done, most of the hard work is done too! There are just a few things to remember to make sure your event goes smoothly:

- Briefly outline the format of the quiz – e.g. repeat the questions twice, the number of rounds, and that the quizmaster has the final say
- Ensure that all teams have pens, answer sheets and that they have paid for their ticket
- Take lots of photos you can use on your social media sites or website
- Ask participants to tweet about the event and check-in on Facebook
- If there is a tie, use your tie breaker question
- Most importantly, **HAVE FUN!**
