



Jaundice in your newborn baby?

Do they have any of these signs and symptoms?

Yellowing of their skin and/or eyes



Yellow Urine

A newborn baby's urine should be colourless. If your baby's urine is yellow tell your doctor, health visitor or midwife

Pale Poo

Healthy Stools



Suspect Stools



Stools suspect – tell your doctor, health visitor or midwife

If your baby is still jaundiced two weeks after birth (three weeks in a premature baby) tell your doctor, health visitor or midwife and ask for a split bilirubin test
